Media Accreditations



Accreditations are issued on the matchday at the accreditation point at the front office – entry in Łazienkowska Street. Issuing start two hours before match, and ends fifteen minutes after kick-off.

Collection in person. In case of planned absence give us proper notice.

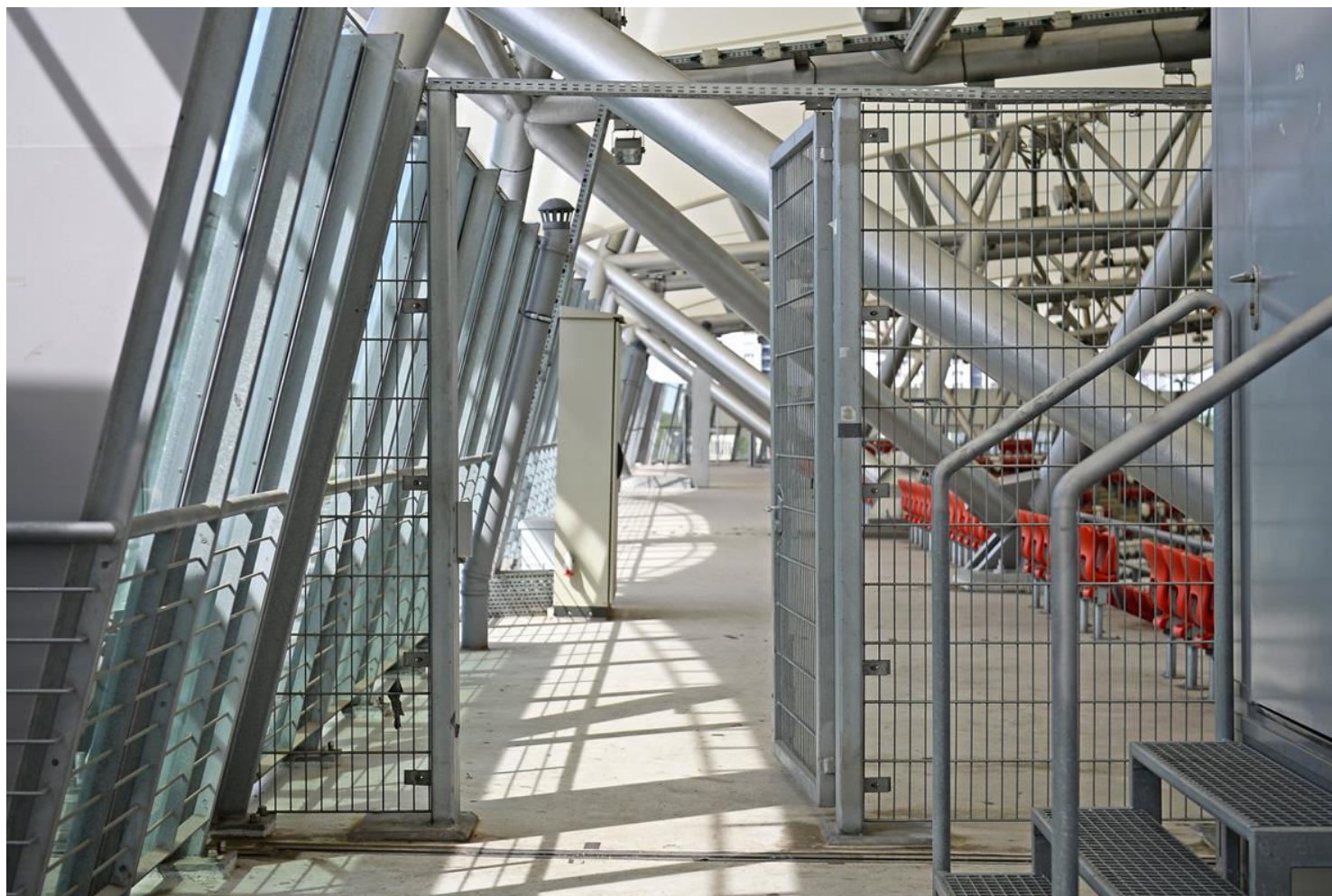
Each place in the media enclosure has a table, a power outlet and Wi-Fi connection.

Before the match, at half-time, and after the final whistle there are food and drinks for journalists.



Accredited press are welcome to the Press Office before kick-off, at half-time, and after the game. Office is placed on the first floor.



Next to the Press Office there is a conference room, where after-match press conferences are held.



Mixed Zone



Mixed zone is placed on the ground floor in the corridor near locker rooms. Entry is only for authorised journalists and TV Crew who don't have rights for working on the pitch (in agreement with Ekstraklasa law cameras must be deposited in the Press Office).

Photographers



After collecting the accreditation, photographers go to the gate in northwest corner in Łazienkowska Street.

Photo bibs are provided in Media Reception placed in the tunnel.

Under the west stand there is a special room for photojournalists.

During the game, photographers work behind the goals, designated line and ad boards to the 16 metre along the lateral line from east stand.





Photos taken by accredited photographers can be published on websites, but only as pictures.

Publishing films or quasi-video streaming is banned.

Also, smoking is banned on the pitch!





There is a Service Point, where you can:

- Prepare your equipment for the match and get technical support
- Clean camera matrix
- Loan equipment and accessories
- Use computer and send photos to your editorial office



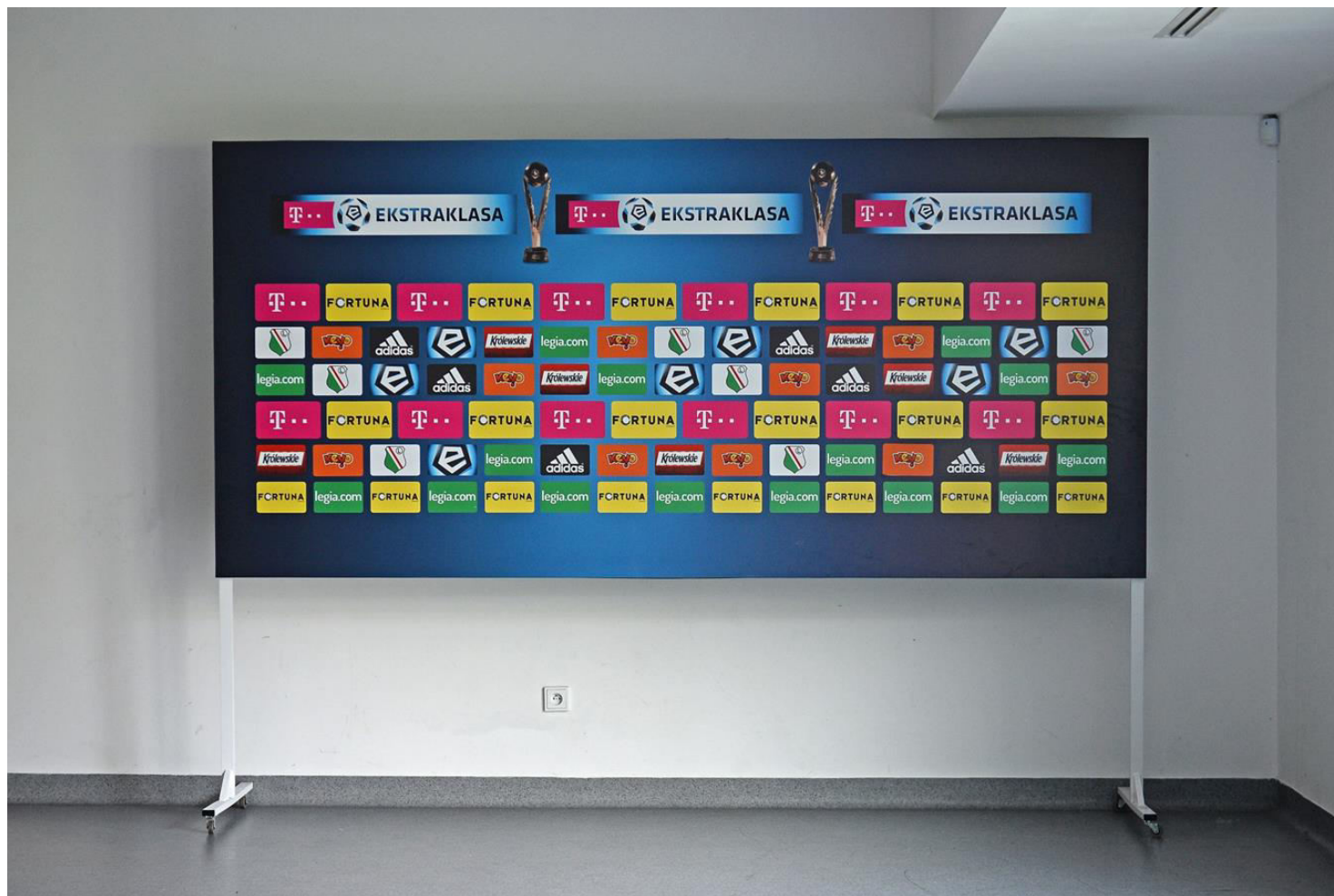


Only journalists working at TV channels which have proper rights can work on the pitch.

PS TV i PP TV Bibs (details on Ekstraklasa.org) are provided at the desk placed in the tunnel. TV journalists who don't have proper rights must deposit their cameras in the Press Office during the game. After the match they can go to press conference room or mixed-zone.
